

Cap-n-Corks Brew Bowl Competition

Official Rules

February 4, 2012

1. Cap-n-Corks Brew Bowl is meant to be an informal friendly, fun, head-to-head homebrewed beer competition based loosely on AHA/BJCP rules.
2. Beers will be judged using AHA/BJCP score sheets by locally selected judges in the following categories: Cap-n-Corks reserves the right to expand or contract categories as necessary.
 - Pilsner/Lager
 - Wheat/Rye
 - Bock
 - Stouts/Porters
 - Light/Pale/Amber Ales
 - Red/Brown/Bitter Ales
 - Specialty/Fruit Beers

The best from each category will be judged as a group for overall Grand Champion. It is the responsibility of the entrant to select the appropriate category for their particular beer entry/entries.

3. Contestants must fill out an entry form, pay necessary entry fees and submit at least **two** 12 oz. Or larger bottles per category entered. Entry is required no later than 6 pm, Friday, February 3th, 2012 to be eligible. Entry forms may be filled out and fees paid starting January 17th, 2012 at Cap-n-Corks. Beer submittals may be brought in starting January 24th, 2012.
4. Each entrant will submit a \$5.00 non-refundable entrance fee. This fee will include entry of 1 brew in any particular category. Each additional brew entry will be an additional \$1.00 regardless of category. Contestants may enter as many categories and as many beers as they wish as long as said fees are paid. All entries are automatically entered in the “Best Label” contest. Anyone wishing to enter this additional contest without submitting a beer in one of the 5 categories must still submit an entry form and pay the \$5.00 entry fee.
5. Bottle submittals will be a min. of two 12 oz. or larger bottles: both **without label** or identification and one label of entrant’s choice. (*Please note: Labels containing vulgar language, profanity, nudity or otherwise in poor taste will be rejected.) Entrants are responsible for **submitting their labels on a blank sheet of paper, not on bottles**. Contestants with questionable labels may instead submit two or more unmarked bottles and will be ineligible for “Best Label” contest. Contestants are responsible to keep entries segregated until bottle ID #s are assigned by Cap-n-Corks personnel. Entrant’s bottles will be available for pickup at the conclusion of contest (approximately 5 pm - February 4th, 2012). All bottles left after close of business February 18th, 2012 become property of Cap-n-Corks, LLC. No Exceptions.

Prizes –
